OTP Banka Slovensko	31570020000000001341	On 26 November 2020, KBC Group NV, indirectly, and KBC Bank NV, directly, acquired a holding of 99.44% in OTP Banka Slovensko, a.s. and gained control over it. Therefore, OTP Banka Slovensko, a.s. qualifies as a new subsidiary of KBC Group NV. Accordingly, its name was added in the SI list.
Piraeus Financial Holdings S.A.	M6AD1Y1KW32H8THQ6F76	On 31 December 2020 in the context of group restructuring Piraeus Bank, S.A. licence was withdrawn, and the entity became a financial holding. The name was also changed to Piraeus Financial Holdings S.A.
Piraeus Bank S.A	213800OYHR1MPQ5VJL60	In the context of group restructuring former Piraeus Bank, S.A. (currently Piraeus Financial Holdings S.A.) licence was withdrawn and the entity became a financial holding. On 30 December 2020 a new credit institution Piraeus Bank S.A. (GR017N) has been authorised as subsidiary of Piraeus Financial Holdings S.A.
